Work with the children to allocate characters and prepare a short performance. Discuss the stage directions in advance and make sure the children understand how to follow the script.

Dom Dog: I am Dom Dog.

I am in my new boat.

I have a new jacket and a new hat.

(Pat Cat sees Dom Dog's boat.)

Pat Cat: Can I go in the boat, Dom Dog?

Dom Dog: Yes, you can.

Pat Cat: Thank you!

(Pat Cat goes in the boat.

Andy Ant is near the river.)

Dom Dog: Look, it is Andy Ant.

Pat Cat: Hello, Andy Ant!

Andy Ant: Hello, Pat Cat! Hello, Dom Dog!

Can I go in the boat, too?

Dom Dog: Yes, you can.

(Andy Ant goes in the boat.)

Pat Cat: Nice glasses, Andy!



Dom Dog and his Boat Role-play

Andy Ant: Thank you, Pat Cat.

They are new glasses.

(Gus Goat is near the river.)

Dom Dog: Look, it is Gus Goat.

Andy Ant: Hello, Gus!

Pat Cat: Hello, Gus!

Gus Goat: Hello! Can I sit with Andy?

Dom Dog: Yes, you can.

(Gus Goat gets in the boat.)

Dom Dog: You are too quick, Gus Goat!

Andy Ant: Help!

(The boat moves around. Gus Goat kicks Pat Cat.)

Pat Cat: Gus Goat!

Dom Dog: Water is in the boat!

Andy Ant is on my jacket!

(Dom Dog, Pat Cat, Andy Ant, and Gus Goat fall in the river.

Jock Horse is near the river.)

Pat Cat: I see Jock Horse.

Jock Horse has socks.

Jock, help us!

Jock Horse: Can I go in the boat, Pat Cat?

Dom Dog: No, Jock. It is my boat!
