Miss Rabbit: You must pedal with your feet!

(Emily Elephant and her family go to see

Miss Rabbit.)

Narrator: Emily Elephant and her family are going on

a boat, too.

Daddy Elephant: We would like this one, please.

(Danny Dog and Captain Dog go to see

Miss Rabbit.)

Danny Dog and Captain Dog are going on Narrator:

a boat, too.

Captain Dog: We would like this one, please.

(The three families float about in their boats.)

Narrator: The families are on their boats!

Peppa: You must pedal, Daddy.

Daddy Pig: This is not easy.

(The families start eating their picnics on

the boats.)

The families are hungry now. Narrator:

They eat a picnic. The children love picnics!

(Miss Rabbit calls them from the shore.)

Come back now! Miss Rabbit:

Mommy Pig: Who can come back first?

Narrator: Daddy Pig pedals and pedals.

Daddy Pig: This is not easy!

Captain Dog comes back first. Narrator:

Captain Dog: I love going on a boat.

Peppa and her friends love going on boats, too! Narrator:
