Narrator:

(Topsy, Tim, Mommy, and Dad are on a bus.)

Narrator:

On Monday, Topsy and Tim see the
Tower of London.

Topsy:

It's very big!

Tim:

We like the Tower of London.

*(Topsy, Tim, Mommy, and Dad get on an
underground train.)*

Narrator:

On Tuesday, the twins go
on a train under the streets.

(Topsy, Tim, Mommy, and Dad see some soldiers.)

Narrator:

Mommy wants to see the horses and soldiers.

Tim:

The horses are very big!



Topsy: The soldiers are great!
(Topsy, Tim, Mommy, and Dad are on a boat.)

Narrator: On Wednesday, Topsy and Tim go on a boat.

Topsy: I can see a big clock.

Mommy: That clock is Big Ben.

(Topsy and Tim play in a park.)

Narrator: The boat goes to a big park. Topsy and Tim enjoy playing there.

(Topsy, Tim, Mommy, and Dad are at a dinosaur museum.)

Narrator: On Thursday, Topsy and Tim see dinosaurs.

Topsy: This dinosaur is great!

Narrator: One dinosaur has got very big teeth!
Topsy and Tim do not like it!

Tim: That dinosaur has got very big teeth!

(Topsy and Tim play on a boat in a playground.)

Narrator: On Friday, Topsy and Tim go to a big playground.
They like playing in the playground.

Tim: I like this big boat.

Narrator: Topsy and Tim go home.

Tim: London is great!

Topsy: Our home is great, too!
