Work with the children to allocate characters and prepare a short performance. Discuss the stage directions in advance and make sure the children understand how to follow the script.

*(Peppa and her friends are at school.
Madame Gazelle is looking at the roof.)*

Madame Gazelle:

There are holes in the school roof. Let's have a rummage sale. We can get money for a new roof.

(Peppa is at home sorting through her toys.)

Narrator:

Peppa gives some toys to the rummage sale.

Peppa:

I can give this toy, too.

(Peppa sits on Daddy Pig's chair.)

Peppa:

You can give this old chair, Daddy.

Daddy Pig:

No. This is a very good chair.

(Madame Gazelle visits Peppa's house. Peppa and Mommy Pig give her the unwanted toys and Daddy Pig's old chair.)

Mommy Pig:

You can have this old chair, too.



(Peppa, George, Mommy Pig, Daddy Pig, and Peppa's friends go to the rummage sale at the school. Peppa sees Daddy Pig's chair.)

Narrator: Daddy Pig's old chair is at the rummage sale. Peppa and her friends see the toys.

Peppa My old toy is very nice. I want my old toy. Here is some money.

(Peppa buys her toy back from the rummage sale.)

Narrator: Peppa's friends want their old toys back, too.

(Peppa's friends buy their old toys back from the rummage sale.)

(Daddy Pig sees his chair.)

Daddy Pig I have this chair.

(Daddy Pig buys his chair back from the rummage sale.)

Now, I have two blue chairs.

Mommy Pig No. It IS your old chair!

Daddy Pig Oh! Now, I have no money.

(Madame Gazelle holds the money from the rummage sale.)

Madame Gazelle: Great! We have got a lot of money. Now, the school can have a new roof!
