Work with the children to allocate characters and prepare a short performance. Discuss the stage directions in advance and make sure the children understand how to follow the script.

(Peppa, George, and Grandpa Pig are in the garden.)

Narrator: Grandpa Pig gives Peppa a lettuce.

Peppa: What is that?

(Peppa points at the lettuce.)

Grandpa Pig: It is a snail.



Narrator: George likes the snail.

(The snail disappears into its shell.)

Peppa: Where is the snail now, Grandpa?

Grandpa Pig: It is in its shell. The shell is the snail's house.

Narrator: George likes the snail's shell. Peppa likes it, too.

Peppa: Can we be snails in our houses?

(Peppa and George pretend that they have shells.)

(Peppa and George's friends arrive.)

Narrator: Peppa and George's friends come to the garden.
Bzzz! Bzzz! Bzzz!

Friends: What is that?
(Grandpa Pig shows the children a beehive.)

Grandpa Pig: They are bees.

Peppa: What are they doing?

Grandpa Pig: They are making honey.

Peppa: I like honey!

Friends: Let's be bees!

(The children start to play.)

Bzzz! Bzzz! Bzzz!

(Granny Pig arrives in the garden.)

Narrator: Granny Pig is in the garden.
She gives Peppa and her friends some honey
on bread.

Peppa: I like bees!

Friends: We like bees, too! We like eating their honey.
It's great!
