Narrator:

*(The children are playing a game of football
The moms and dads are watching.)*

Narrator:

Ollie and Jess play on Jon's team.
The blue and yellow team get three goals!
Jon's team do not get any goals.

(The blue and yellow team celebrate.)

Narrator:

The blue and yellow team are very happy.
Jon's team are not very happy.

*(Jon, his dad and Jon's team go to a big
football game.)*

Narrator:

Jon and his dad go to a big football game. Jon's team go to the game, too. Ben Wills gets four goals.



(Jon and his team are in the park.)

Narrator: Jon and his team like Ben Wills.

Jess: Ben Wills is great!

(Jon's team play another game of football.)

Narrator: Jon's team play the blue and yellow team again.

(Jess kicks the ball to Ollie.)

Ben Wills: Very good, Jess!

Narrator: Ollie kicks the ball to Jon.

Ben Wills: Very good, Ollie!

Narrator: Jon kicks the ball.

Ben Wills: Very good, Jon!

(Jon scores a goal. His team win the game.)

Narrator: The blue and yellow team do not get any goals.
Jon's team are very happy.

(The game ends and the children join their parents.)

Moms and Dads:

Good game!

Narrator: The man speaks to Jon's team. He is Ben Wills.

(Ben Wills shakes hands with Jon.)

Ben Wills: Good game, team. Good goal, Jon!

Narrator: Jon is very happy.
