Narrator: Topsy and her brother, Tim, are twins.

They have the same birthday. Topsy and Tim

like going to the farm with Mommy.

(Topsy, Tim, and Mommy are at the farm.)

Topsy: Can we help?

Mommy: You can get some eggs.

(Topsy and Tim are with the hens and the ducks.)

Narrator: Topsy and Tim see the hens and the ducks.

Topsy: Look at the baby ducks!

Narrator: Then, Topsy and Tim see some big geese.

Tim: I do not like geese.

(Topsy and Tim collect eggs from the

hens and take them to Mommy.)



Narrator: Topsy and Tim get some eggs. They take

them to Mommy.

(Topsy and Tim walk up to some cows.)

Narrator: The twins see some cows. The cows are very big.

Topsy and Tim cannot find a gate.

(The farmer calls to the twins.)

Here is the gate! Farmer:

(The farmer takes the twins into the cowshed.)

Farmer: Come and look. We have a baby cow at the farm.

(The farmer takes the twins to see the baby cow.)

A calf is a baby cow. Let's give her some milk. Farmer:

Topsy: Yes, please!

(Topsy feeds the calf.)

Topsy helps the calf. She gives her some milk. Narrator:

Topsy: I like this calf.

(Tim helps the calf.)

Tim helps the calf, too. Narrator:

(The twins run back to Mommy.)

The calf is drinking her milk. She is very happy! Tim:

(The farmer arrives in his tractor.)

Farmer: You are very good, Topsy and Tim.

Here are some eggs.

Topsy and Tim: We like going to the farm!
