Work with the children to allocate characters and prepare a short performance. Discuss the stage directions in advance and make sure the children understand how to follow the script.

(Topsy, Tim, Mommy, and Dad are at the zoo.)

Narrator:

Topsy and Tim like going to the zoo with Mommy and Dad. They like seeing the animals.

(They go to see the penguins.)

Topsy and Tim: Here are the penguins! Can we have a penguin?

Mommy:

No, you cannot have a penguin!

(They go to see the parrots.)

Topsy and Tim: Look! Parrots! Can we have a parrot?

Dad:

No, you cannot have a parrot!

(They go to see the giraffes.)

Topsy and Tim: Here are the giraffes! Can we have a giraffe?

Mommy:

No, you cannot have a giraffe!

(They go to see the zebras.)

Topsy and Tim: Look, zebras! Can we have a zebra?



Dad: No, you cannot have a zebra!

(They go to see the polar bears.)

Topsy and Tim: Here are the polar bears! Can we have a polar bear?

Mommy: No, you cannot have a polar bear!

(They go to see the lions.)

Topsy and Tim: Look! Lions! Can we have a lion?

Dad: No, you cannot have a lion!

(They go to see the seals.)

Topsy and Tim: Look! Seals! Can we have a seal?

Mommy: No, you cannot have a seal!

(They go to see the monkeys.)

Topsy and Tim: There are the monkeys! Can we have a monkey?

Dad: No, you cannot have a monkey!

Narrator: Topsy and Tim go home.

Topsy: I like the animals at the zoo.

(Topsy, Tim, and Dad are in the garden.)

Dad: Look! A dog, a cat, and a rabbit!
We have got a zoo at home!
