(Peppa and her family arrive at the forest.

Daddy Pig holds a map.)

the forest. Daddy Pig has got the map.

Mommy Pig: We need our picnic, too. It is in the car.

But Daddy Pig did not hear Mommy Pig. Narrator:

(Peppa sees some footprints on the ground.)

Then, Peppa saw something near her feet. Narrator:

(They follow the footprints. Peppa sees some birds.)

Peppa: Look down there! I can see some ants!

(The family continue their walk.)

Narrator: Peppa and her family were hungry.

Peppa: Where is our picnic?

Daddy Pig: Oh no! It is in the car.

(Daddy Pig looks at the map.)

Daddy Pig: Do we go right or left?

(Peppa sees the family's own footprints.)

Peppa: I can see our footprints, too. They can take

us back to the picnic in our car!

(They follow the footprints, but it starts

to rain and the footprints disappear.)

Narrator: Then, it started to rain.

Daddy Pig: Now we cannot see our footprints.

(Peppa sees some ducks.)

Peppa: I can see some ducks. Ducks love the rain AND

they love picnics. They can take us to our car!

(They follow the ducks back to the car.)

Narrator: The ducks took the hungry family back to

their car.

(They eat the picnic.)
