Mrs Tiggy-Winkle

Work with the children to allocate characters and prepare a short performance. Discuss the stage directions in advance and make sure the children understand how to follow the script.

(Squirrel Nutkin has lost Old Brown's glasses. Peter, Lily, and Benjamin help him look for them.)

Peter:

Where did Squirrel Nutkin put the glasses?

(Jeremy Fisher walks past.)

Lily:

Let's ask Jeremy Fisher.

Jeremy Fisher: I'm sorry. I don't know.

Narrator:

Then, Old Brown flew down from the sky.

(Old Brown flies down and scares the friends.)

Old Brown:

I want my glasses, Squirrel Nutkin!

Lily:

Come in here!

(The rabbits and Squirrel Nutkin hide under a table. Peter sees a rabbit hole.)

Peter:

Let's go!

Narrator:

All the friends ran behind him. Old Brown flew after them, but he could not catch them.





Old Brown: Come back here, Squirrel Nutkin!
(The friends look for the glasses outside.)

Peter: Where are Old Brown's glasses?
(They see Mrs. Tiggy-Winkle.)

Benjamin: Let's ask Mrs. Tiggy-Winkle.

Narrator: But Mrs. Tiggy-Winkle didn't know.
(Squirrel Nutkin stands on Mrs. Tiggy-Winkle's clean clothes.)

Mrs Tiggy-Winkle: Nutkin is putting berry stains on my clean clothes!
(Old Brown flies over and chases Squirrel Nutkin into the forest.)

Peter: Where are Old Brown's glasses?

Lily: Nutkin made berry stains. Do you remember?

Benjamin: Yes! We must go to the berry trees!
(The rabbits run to the berry trees.)

Peter: Look! Here are the glasses! Come here, Old Brown! I've got your glasses.
(Peter drops the glasses off the side of the treehouse.)

Narrator: Then, Peter dropped the glasses.

(Old Brown flies after his glasses.)

Narrator:

He flew down to his glasses.
Then, he flew into the trees.
