Work with the children to allocate characters and prepare a short performance. Discuss the stage directions in advance and make sure the children understand how to follow the script.

Narrator:

(The little old woman takes the gingerbread man from the oven.)

Narrator:

The little old woman took the gingerbread man from the oven. He jumped from her hands and ran from the house.

(The gingerbread man runs out of the house.)

Old Woman:

Stop, little gingerbread man! I want to eat you.

(The little old woman chases the gingerbread man out of the house.)

Narrator:

But the gingerbread man did not stop. He ran and ran. The little old woman ran too, but she did not catch him.

(The gingerbread man runs past a cow.)

Narrator:

Soon, the gingerbread man met a cow.



Cow: Stop, little gingerbread man! I want to eat you.

(The little old woman and the cow chase the gingerbread man.)

Narrator: But the gingerbread man did not stop.
He ran and ran. The cow ran too, but she did not catch him.

(The gingerbread man runs past a horse.)

Narrator: Soon, the gingerbread man met a horse.

Horse: Stop, little gingerbread man! I want to eat you.

(The little old woman, the cow and the horse chase the gingerbread man.)

Narrator: But the gingerbread man did not stop.
He ran and ran. The horse ran too, but he did not catch him.

*(The gingerbread man comes to a river.
He meets a fox there.)*

Gingerbread

Man: I must cross the river.

Fox: Jump on my tail.

(The gingerbread man jumped on the fox's tail.)

Gingerbread

Man: My feet are in the water.

Fox: Jump on my back.



(The gingerbread man jumped on the fox's back.)

Gingerbread

Man:

My feet are in the water.

Fox:

Jump on my head.

(The gingerbread man jumped on the fox's head.)

Fox:

I'm hungry!

(The fox eats the gingerbread man.)
