It wanted to catch the little red bird and the duck.
- 2 Which animals did the wolf want to catch?
It wanted to catch the little red bird, the duck, and the cat.
- 3 What did the cat and the wolf want to do with the animals?
They wanted to eat them.

- 4 What could the bird and the duck do that the cat and the wolf couldn't do?
They could fly and swim.

- 1 The cat climbed **to** the very top of the tree.
- 2 The frightened duck jumped **out** of the pond.
- 3 The hungry wolf caught her **in** his big mouth!

- 5 The little red bird sat **safely** at the top of the big tree.

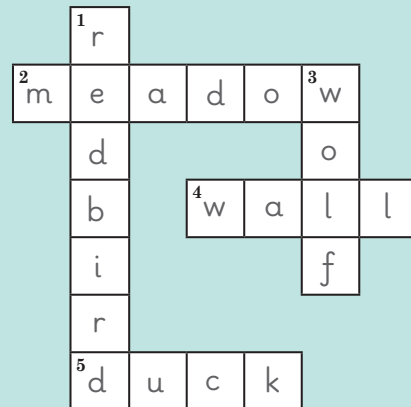
