

Work with the children to allocate characters and prepare a short performance. Discuss the stage directions in advance and make sure the children understand how to follow the script.

	(Snow White is in the forest, where the huntsman left her.)
Narrator 1:	Snow White ran and ran. Soon, she came to a little house. She went inside, because she was very tired.
Narrator 2:	In the house, she saw seven little chairs and seven little beds.
Narrator 1:	Snow White went to sleep on the beds.
Narrator 2:	Soon, the dwarfs who lived in the house came home.
Dwarfs:	Why is this beautiful woman asleep in our house?
Narrator 1:	Snow White woke up.
Snow White:	Who are you?
A Dwarf:	We are the seven dwarfs. We work in the forest.
Snow White:	The bad queen wants to kill me.
Narrator 2:	The dwarfs thought for a few seconds.
A Dwarf:	You can stay here. Don't open this door, or speak to people who come to it.



Narrator 1:	That evening, the queen asked her mirror,
Queen:	Who is the most beautiful woman in the world?
Magic Mirror:	Snow White.
Narrator 2:	The queen was angry. She put on different clothes, went into the forest, and found the little house.
	(The queen is at the door of the dwarfs' house.)
Queen:	Come and see my beautiful ribbons.
Narrator 1:	Snow White looked at the ribbons.
Narrator 2:	Then, the queen put one ribbon round Snow White's neck. The ribbon hurt!
Narrator 1:	The dwarfs came home and found Snow White on the floor. Was she dead?
Narrator 2:	No—she woke up!
	(That evening the mirror tells the queen again.)
Magic Mirror:	Snow White is the most beautiful woman in the world.
Narrator 1:	The queen was very angry, and she took some combs to the house.
Queen:	Look at my beautiful combs.
Snow White:	I mustn't speak to people who come to the door.
Queen:	Then I can leave the comb here.
Narrator 2:	The queen left. Snow White put the comb in her hair, and fell to the floor.
