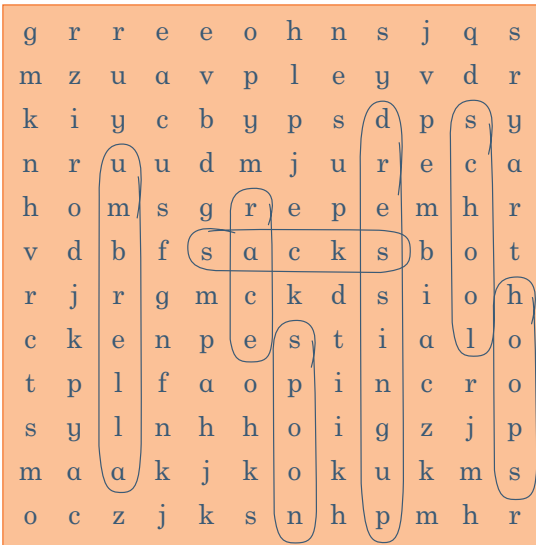

A: Good. I like orange!
