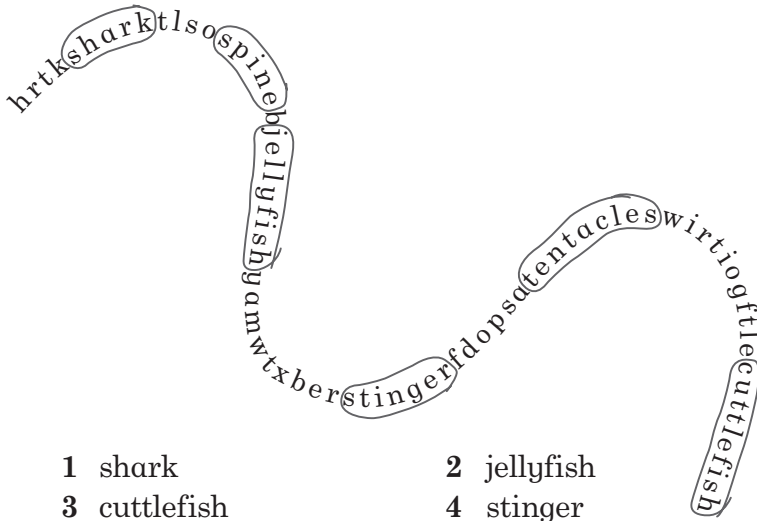

Model answers

- 1 Which animals are these?
They are an angler fish and a gulper eel.
- 2 Where do they live?
They live in the bottom of the oceans.
- 3 What can they make?
They can make a bright light.
- 4 Where are their lights?
The angler fish has a light on its head, and the gulper eel has a light on its tail.
- 5 Why do they do this?
They make a bright light so that fish will swim close to them and they can eat the fish!
