Work with the children to allocate characters and prepare a short performance. Discuss the stage directions in advance and make sure the children understand how to follow the script.

George is with his friend, Edmond Elephant. Narrator:

They are playing with their toy rocket.

Narrator: Peppa is there, too.

(The rocket lands on Peppa's head.)

Oh no! The toy rocket is on Peppa's head. Narrator:

(Mommy and Daddy Pig arrive.)

Daddy Pig: Are you on the moon, Peppa?

Peppa: No. I don't like the moon!

Mommy Pig: The moon is great. You can

learn about it at the museum.

Peppa, George,

and Edmond: Let's go!

Narrator: The family is at the museum.

Miss Rabbit: Learn about the moon here!

I can teach you about the moon. Mr Rabbit:

Narrator: Peppa and her family sit in a big rocket.

Peppa: Where are we going?

Mr Rabbit: We are going to the moon!

Mr Rabbit: Here's the moon!

Narrator: Peppa and her friends love going on boats, too!

Daddy Pig: Is the moon α big cheese?

Mr Rabbit: No, it's not α cheese! It's α big rock.

Mr Rabbit: People can't walk on the moon. They fly.

(Rubber bands drop down. They all bounce up

and down)

Mommy Pig: Look, rubber bands! Let's fly on the moon!

Narrator: Miss Rabbit takes a picture with her camera.

Narrator: The rocket comes back from the moon.

(They all go to the museum shop. Miss Rabbit is

the counter.)

Narrator: The family goes to the museum's shop.

Daddy Pig: Can I have some moon cheese, please.

(Miss Rabbit shows Peppa a picture of the family

on the moon.)

Narrator: Peppa looks at Miss Rabbit's picture.

Peppa: Look, we're flying! Now, I like the moon!
