

Work with the children to allocate characters and prepare a short performance. Discuss the stage directions in advance and make sure the children understand how to follow the script.

	(Martin and Lorna are digging.)
Narrator 1:	Martin and Lorna are farmers.
Narrator 2:	Martin has a turnip farm and Lorna has a leek farm.
	(Martin digs up a huge turnip.)
Narrator 1:	A turnip fit for a king!
Martin:	Wow!
	(Lorna digs up a huge leek.)
Narrator 2:	A leek fit for a queen!
Lorna:	Wow!
	(It is raining. Martin and Lorna take the turnip and the leek into town.)
Narrator 1:	Martin joins Lorna on the road to town.
Narrator 2:	It is wet, wet!

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	(Martin and Lorna are at the palace.)
Narrator 1:	Martin bows to the king.
Martin:	This turnip is all for you!
Narrator 2:	Lorna tells the queen the leek is all for her.
Narrator 1:	The king and queen go off for a chat.
king:	This turnip is not for me!
queen:	This leek is not for me!
Narrator 2:	The butler tells Martin and Lorna they can now join the king and queen.
Martin:	This turnip is for the queen!
Lorna:	This leek is for the king!
Narrator 1:	The king and queen had turnip and leek for supper.
queen:	Wow!
king:	Wow!
