Rival Bear

Work with the children to allocate characters and prepare a short performance. Discuss the stage directions in advance and make sure the children understand how to follow the script.

(Bear has a fishing rod and a bucket.)

Narrator 1: Bear is going fishing.

Narrator 2: Masha comes to Bear's house.

Masha: Can I have some breakfast, please?

(Bear and Masha are in the kitchen.)

Narrator 1: Bear gives Masha some cereal and milk.

Masha: Yuck! I don't like cereal.

Narrator 2: Bear gives Masha some eggs.

Masha: Yuck! I don't like eggs.

Narrator 1: Bear gives Masha a sandwich.

Masha: Yuck! I don't want a sandwich. I want candy!

Narrator 2: Bear is not happy. Candy is not breakfast food.

Narrator 1: Bear goes fishing.

(Bear and Rival Bear are fishing together.)

Narrator 2: Oh no! Rival Bear has lots of fish.

(Bear looks sad.)

Narrator 1: There are no fish in the water for Bear.

(Masha is in the kitchen. She is making candy.)

Narrator 2: Masha gets some sugar, water, and fruit.

Masha: Mmm, candy!

Narrator 1: Masha makes a lot of candy.

Narrator 2: Then, she eats her candy.

Masha: Mmm, candy!

Narrator 1: Then, Bear comes home. Bear is not happy!

Narrator 2: Bear gives Masha a toothbrush.

Narrator 1: Masha does not want a toothbrush.

She wants candy.

(Masha is holding her mouth in pain.)

Narrator 2: Now, Masha has a toothache.

Masha: Ouch!

(Bear takes Masha to see the Wolves.)

Narrator 1: Bear goes to the Wolves' house with Masha.

Wolves: Open your mouth.

Narrator 2: Masha opens her mouth, but she is not happy.

Masha: I'm going home! Goodbye!

Narrator 1: Masha runs. Then, she falls.

Narrator 2: Bear finds Masha.

(Masha's tooth has fallen out. She's holding it in

her hand.)

Masha: I don't have a toothache. Look, here is my tooth!

(Masha eats candy. Then, she brushes her teeth.)

Narrator 1: Now, Masha eats candy and then she cleans

her teeth!
