Narrator 1

Work with the children to allocate characters and prepare a short performance. Discuss the stage directions in advance and make sure the children understand how to follow the script.

> (The Moomins are going on a boat trip. Moomin is trying to decide which fishing rod to take.)

Narrator 1: Moomin liked fishing, but today he couldn't choose a

fishing rod.

(Moomin holds two fishing rods.)

Moomin: Mmm . . . Which one? The red one or the yellow one?

(Moominpappa is trying on hats.)

Narrator 2: Moominpappa couldn't choose a hat.

Moominpappa: Mmm . . . Which hat for the boat? The black hat? The

yellow hat for the rain? Or both? And I must take my

top hat, of course!

(Moominmamma and Little My are collecting berries.)

Narrator 1: Moominmamma and Little My wanted to take

lots of berries with them for the picnic.

Moominmamma: Berries are good to eat and we can make lots of

juice from them, too.

Little My: Good! I love berry juice!

Moomin: Mmm! I like berry juice, too!

Now, where's Snorkmaiden? Is she ready?

Narrator 2: Snorkmaiden couldn't choose her clothes for the trip.

Snorkmaiden: Oh dear! What can I wear? Can you help me, Moomin?

(Snorkmaiden holds up two dresses; a blue one and a

pink one.)

Snorkmaiden: Do you like the blue dress or the pink one?

Moomin: They both look nice, but I like the pink one better.

Narrator 1: After many hours, they were all ready and the

boat was full.

Moomin and

Snorkmaiden: Now, let's go and look for treasure!

Narrator 2: Oh dear! It was late!

Little My: (Sadly) There's no sun!

Moominpappa: No, there isn't. But we have the moonlight!

Narrator 1: Then, in the moonlight, they started their trip.

Moominpappa: Let's look for an island!

All: (Happily) Yes!

Narrator 2: Snorkmaiden was excited. She put her hand into

the water.

Snorkmaiden: There's treasure! I can see treasure! Down there!

Little My: That's not treasure! It's only the moonlight.

Moomin: I think that it's treasure!

Narrator 1: Then, Moomin jumped into the water. He swam

down and down . . . At the bottom, he saw a

beautiful pearl inside a shell!

Narrator 2: Snorkmaiden, Little My, Moominmamma, and

Moominpappa all looked into the water, but they

couldn't see Moomin.

Snorkmaiden: Oh dear. Is he all right?

Narrator 1: Then, Moomin swam back to the boat.

Snorkmaiden: (Happily) Oh, Moomin!

Moomin: It WAS treasure! Look!

Narrator 2: He showed Snorkmaiden the beautiful shell. The

pearl inside it was the same color as the moon.

Snorkmaiden: It's beautiful!

Moomin: It's for you!

Narrator 1: After a few minutes, Moominpappa saw something.

Moominpappa: I can see an island!

Moominmamma: Good! Let's have our picnic there.

Narrator 2: They made a nice fire and enjoyed their picnic in

the moonlight.

Narrator 1: Moominpappa told them stories about the sea.

Narrator 2: They talked most about Moomin and the pearl.

Then, they all felt very tired.

Narrator 1: Snorkmaiden put her head next to Moomin's head.

Snorkmaiden: Thank you, Moomin! Thank you for my treasure.

It's beautiful.

Narrator 2: Moomin was very, very happy!

Moomin: Tomorrow, I can find you more treasure.

Narrator 1: Snorkmaiden didn't hear him—she was asleep!
