b **Model answers**: 1c Geckos live in the sand. Bonobo monkeys and drongo birds live in trees; 2b Foxes make their nests underground. Barnacle geese and termites make their nests above ground; 3a Snakes don't have a shell. Tortoises and turtles do; 4a Crabs are small sea animals. Parrotfish and sharks are big fish; 5b Meerkats have homes. Antelopes and whales do not; 6a Clownfish live with sea anemones. Monkeys and peregrine falcons live near people.
