Hermit Crab video (Book pages 10–11)

- <0:07> These hermit crabs need bigger homes.
<0:23> The crabs get in line ...
<0:32> ... from big to small.
<0:44> The biggest crab takes the big, new shell.
<1:14> Then the other crabs move into the shell of the crab next to them.
<1:52> But one crab does not get its shell!

Grasscutter Ants video (Book pages 16–17)

- <0:13> This grass is very tough.
<0:17> But grasscutter ants can cut the grass with their strong mouths.
<0:27> Then they let the cut grass fall down, and carry it to their nest under the ground.
<0:45> But grasscutter ants can't eat the grass.
<0:52> They feed the grass to fungus that grows in their nest.
<1:02> Then the ants eat the fungus.

Langur Monkeys video (Book pages 28–29)

- <0:05> Langur monkeys are important in India.
<0:10> People give them lots of good food ...
<0:14> ... like fruit, vegetables and flowers.
<0:19> These monkeys are not afraid of people. They take food from their hands.
<0:28> The monkeys eat well ...
<0:38> ... and the mothers can have lots of babies.
<0:58> The babies are happy to play near people.
