Darkling Beetle video (Book pages 10–11)

- <0:10> Darkling beetles wait for fog in the desert early in the morning.
<0:17> Then they run to the top of the sand dune.
<0:47> At the top, they put their heads down and don't move.
<0:57> The fog changes into water drops on their bodies.
<1:14> The drops flow into their mouths.
<1:27> The beetles can drink a lot of water in this hot place.

Tadpoles video (Book pages 14–15)

- <0:05> The little tadpoles in their nest need rain.
<0:35> When it starts to rain, the rain changes the foam nest.
<0:52> Twenty days later, the tadpoles fall from the nest into the water below.
<1:19> The foam falls into the water, too, and the tadpoles eat it to help them grow.

Siberian Chipmunks video (Book pages 20–21)

- <0:13> Siberian chipmunks live in the forest. They eat acorns.
<0:30> They need to store about a kilo of acorns for the long winter months.
<0:38> That's a lot of acorns!
<0:58> And there are lots of other animals in the forest that want the acorns, too.
<1:05> The chipmunks must find the acorns first and put them safely in their burrow.
