<1:00>	This puffin caught a fish and takes it home for his babu.

<0:24>	Giant trevally catch young birds that land on the water.
<0:45>	The fish usually hunt alone, but there are about 50 of them here because there

<1:04>	The birds try to stay away from the water.

	bird.
