Level 2

Puffins video (Book pages 16–17)

- <0:13> Puffins fly very far out to sea looking for fish.
<0:38> They can swim under the water. Their short wings help them do this.
<0:49> They can swim far down and stop breathing for more than a minute.
<1:00> This puffin caught a fish and takes it home for his baby.

Giant Trevally video (Book pages 18–19)

- <0:24> Giant trevally catch young birds that land on the water.
<0:45> The fish usually hunt alone, but there are about 50 of them here because there is a lot of food.
<1:04> The birds try to stay away from the water.
<1:48> But the fish are very clever, and they can jump out of the water and catch a bird.

Octopus and Shark video (Book pages 26–27)

- <0:08> A predator wants to catch and eat this octopus.
<0:21> But the octopus is very clever. It stays where it is, but hides under some shells.
<0:59> The shark is confused.
<1:11> It can't find the octopus between the shells.
<1:18> The octopus escapes.
