Cuttlefish and Crab video (Book pages 6–7)

<0:10> Lots of different animals live together in the coral reef
--

- <0.20> It is a good place to find a home,
- <0:25> food,
- <0:32> and a partner.
- <0:39> But sometimes animals must fight for these things.
- <0:45> It's not always easy to know who is the predator, and who is the prey.
- <0:53> Cuttlefish like hunting crabs.
- <1:22> But a large crab can be dangerous, because it has strong claws.
- <1:29> The cuttlefish will have to be careful.

Desert Long-Eared Bat and Scorpion video (Book pages 22–23)

- <0:05> This desert long-eared bat is hunting a dangerous scorpion.
- <0:22> The venom in its tail can kill a person.
- <0:32> The bat is very small, but it is very hungry.
- <0:41> It must fight and kill the scorpion.
- <0:50> They start fighting ...
- <1:02> ... and the scorpion strikes the bat on its head.
- <1:10> The scorpion strikes again, but it doesn't stop the bat.
- <1:45> It's the first of three scorpions the bat must eat tonight.

Weaver Ant video (Book pages 26–27)

- <0:10> A group of weaver ants is coming to fight another group.
- <0:24> The ant on guard sees the danger ...
- <0:37> ... and tells the others in his nest.
- <0:44> The ants run out to fight, because they must keep their home and babies safe.
- <1:15> They start spraying acid at the attacking ants.
- <1:27> It hurts the attacking ants and they stop fighting.
- <1:42> Now the ants can attack back and chase the other group away.
- <2:00> Their home is safe again.
