Sea Turtles video (Book pages 10–11)

- <0:05> When they are about thirty years old, green sea turtles come back to the beach where they were born to lay their eggs.
- <0:38> They come when the sun starts to set, so that they don't have to walk up the beach while it is so hot.
- <1:11> On this beach, three thousand turtles can come back to dig their nests in the sand in one night.
- <1:28> The turtles lay their eggs, and then, as the sun rises again, they go back to the sea.

Marine Iguanas video (Book pages 18–19)

- <0:06> Marine iguanas lay their eggs in the sand.
- <0:15> A baby marine iguana comes out from the sand.
- <0:28> It must get to the sea.
- <0:54> It has to run very fast to stay safe, because lots of racer snakes want to catch and eat it.
- <1:06> There are lots of snakes here. They live in the rocks.
- <1:28> This time, the baby marine iguana stays safe. The snakes could not catch it.

Draco Lizard video (Book pages 24–25)

- <0:07> Draco lizards live in trees in the jungle.
- <0:12> But only one Draco lizard can live in a tree, so this lizard must find a different home to be safe.
- <0:44> It jumps out of the tree ...
- <0:48> ... and glides through the air to a different tree.
- <1:00> A Draco lizard can glide about thirty metres in one jump!
