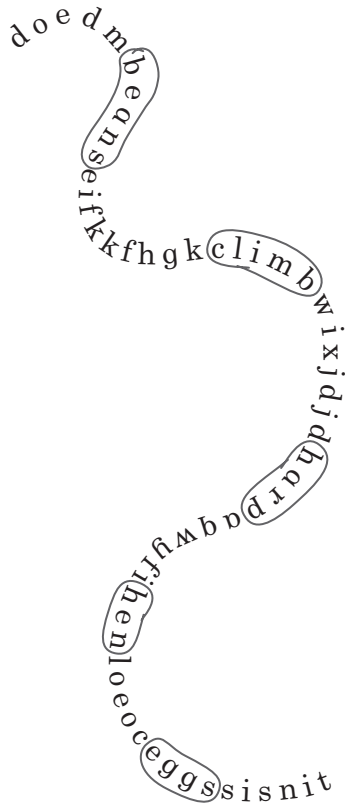
Page 47 – Activity 1
